NOTE: Above product shows how Airmen / their families were assisted by the Air Force Aid Society (AFAS) at this installation. It is easiest to read this starting from the bottom of the page:

-- TOTAL AFAF Campaign Pledges reflects the total dollar amount Airmen pledged during the 2015 Air Force Assistance Fund (AFAF) Campaign. Historically, the actual amount collected is ~ 7% less than the amount pledged.

-- TOTAL AFAS DESIGNATED PLEDGE reflects how much of the total AFAF campaign dollars pledged (see above) was designated by Airmen to the Air Force Aid Society (AFAS). NOTE: There are 4 charities: Air Force Aid Society (AFAS), Air Force Villages Charitable Foundation (AFVCF), Air Force Enlisted Village (AFEV), and the General and Mrs. Curtis E. LeMay Foundation. Again, history shows that the actual amount collected was ~7% less than the amount pledged.

-- TOTAL for the named installation (3rd figure from the bottom) reflects how much the Air Force Aid Society (AFAS) supported this installation's Airmen / Airmen's families through Emergency Assistance loans and /or grants, through Community Programs offered at no cost (grant), and through Education Program grants and loans. The breakout of AFAS support is reflected in the details at the top portion of the page.
