Emergency Assistance = \$7.5M

- ◆ \$6.0M interest-free loans
- ◆ \$1.5M grants
- ◆ 13,886 assists

Vehicle Expenses = \$2.0M
Emergency Travel = \$1.9M
Basic Living = \$2.8M
Funeral Expenses = \$250K
Medical/Dental = \$154K
Child Care/Respite = \$86K
Moving Expenses = \$132K
Miscellaneous = \$240K



- ◆ 83 Wounded Warriors received more than \$131K in assistance — 92% grants

Education Programs = \$6.2M

- ◆ Gen H.H. Arnold Education Grants = \$5.95M
2,332 grants ranging from \$500 to \$4000 for children and spouses
- ◆ Merit Scholarships = \$111K
 - ◇ 51 dependent children earned Merit Scholarships
 - 15 earned \$5,000 scholarships
 - 36 earned \$1,000 scholarships
- ◆ Supplemental Education Loans = \$54K
51 families received no-interest loans to help pay for incidental college expenses



Community Programs = \$1.3M

- ◆ Child Care Programs—16,762 served
