Internal Revenue Service (IRS) Information

"Quid Pro Quo" Statement: IRS rules require a written disclosure statement to donors when a contribution is partly for goods or services. Contributors receive no goods or services in return for contributions to the AFAF Campaign. 100% of AFAF contributions are passed to the designated charity. Contributions to the AFAF are deductible for Federal Income Tax purposes as an itemized deduction.

Receipts: The IRS requires donors to obtain a receipt for any single contribution of \$250 or more. Donations made through payroll deduction each paycheck are regarded as a separate payment documented on the LES. Contributors will obtain a signed receipt (DAF Form 2561) for cash/check donations made to an authorized AFAF Campaign keyworker. Donors making contributions of \$250 or more via check/cashiers check/money order by mail to HQ AFPC will receive a signed receipt for tax purposes via mail (or email if requested). Having access to regularly scheduled transportation gives residents the independence they desire with the safety they require.
